JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.133 dated 28.08.2016, registered under Section 473 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sector 3, U.T. Chandigarh.

Contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. The petitioner has no concern with the Innova vehicle allegedly impounded on the spot. He is not involved in any other FIR. The petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2016.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the present petition. It is submitted that one country-made pistol and four live cartridges were recovered from the petitioner. The challan stands presented and the matter is fixed for framing of charges.

Heard.

The petitioner is not involved in any other FIR. He is in custody since 28.08.2016. Though, the challan stands presented but the charges are yet to be framed, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the trial

is not likely to be concluded in the near future. As many as thirteen witnesses have been cited by the prosecution and all of them are official witnesses.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, anything noticed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
