Petitioner along with Harish Kumar had allegedly prepared a forged cheque of Rs. 15 crores as per the statement made by their co-accused Rakesh Chaudhary in police custody. An attempt was made by said Rakesh Chaudhary to encash the amount but he was apprehended by the police on the basis of valid suspicion.

Since imminent wrongful loss had been evaded with the timely vigilance of the complainant Bank; challan having already been presented; co-accused of the petitioner having been granted concession of regular/pre-arrest bail, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail as the trial is likely to take a long time.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
