This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.130 dated 27.06.2015, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, Punjab.

Without even advertng to the merits of the case, suffice it to notice that co-accused Santokh Singh etc. have been granted concession of pre-arrest bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the light of order dated 21.09.2015 passed in CRM No. M-24519 of 2015.

It has been conceded by learned State counsel that the allegations against Santokh Singh who is the father of the present petitioner are identical in nature.

On the ground of parity itself, the present petitioner is held entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 22.12.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
