INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Ajay alias Ajju has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.169 dated 25.03.2016 registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 427 and 506 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Shiv Charan Bhola, Advocate has appeared and filed memo of appearance on behalf of the complainant and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR; he has been stated to be armed with *danda* and simple injury has been attributed to him. He is not the main accused. The main

allegation is against accused Raju that he had fired from his pistol.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.06.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50000/- with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
