The present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.567 dated 26.6.2016 registered under Sections 379, 414, 411, 201 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar.

The submissions made by Mr.Ashit Malik, Advocate representing the petitioner and Mr.Karan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana have been heard.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has been

implicated in the present case on the disclosure statement of his co-accused Jagmohan and Gurmail. The final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been presented in the court. No recovery was effected from the petitioner.

Affidavit of Shamsher Singh Dahiya, Superintendent, Central Jail-I, Hisar showing the custody details of the petitioner has been filed by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender as he is involved in number of cases of similar nature, details of which are mentioned in the aforesaid affidavit.

As per the affidavit of Superintendent, Central Jail, Central Jail-I, Hisar the petitioner is facing trail in nine other criminal cases of similar nature registered during the years 2014 to 2016.

Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant regular bail to him. As such, the present petition is dismissed.
