Petitioner has sought consideration for change of branch from Computer Science Engineering to Civil Engineering.

Vide interim order dated 26.08.2009, the petitioner was allowed to be shifted to the said course and to pursue his course, accordingly. Respondent-University challenged the interim order vide LPA-876-2009 and the said appeal was dismissed on 11.09.2009.

Counsel for respondent-University submits that the said student has, now, passed out the said course and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Keeping in view the above facts, it is apparent that the issue is purely academic, as to whether principle of rounding off is to apply in favour of the petitioner whereby he was required to have 85% marks in all subjects, but he had only 84.5% in the subject of Public Administration, which led to the denial. Accordingly, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has passed out and the interim order has been confirmed by the Division Bench, the present writ petition is disposed of, by directing the respondent-University to issue the regular certificate, if the needful is not already done.
