M.M.S. BEDI, JUDGE (ORAL)

Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 10.11.2015 in a case registered at the instance of Mohammad Yunis alleging that on 08.11.2015, while the complainant was driving the truck along with his Cleaner, towards Azadpur Market, they were waylaid by a Tata Ace vehicle which halted in front of the truck. 10-12 young boys allegedly armed with dattar and dandas, damaged the truck and snatched sum of Rs.60,000/- from complainant Mohammad Yunis. They also snatched two mobiles and escaped from the spot. One of the accused was allegedly wearing a police uniform. The statement of Mohammad Yunis has already been recorded. Out of total 18 prosecution witnesses, only two have been examined.

Taking into consideration the nature of allegations and status of the trial, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of six months. In case, the trial is not concluded within the above said period, the trial Court shall itself release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
