This order shall dispose of RFA Nos. 3869 to 3871 of 2002  
and 4565 to 4570 of 2003.

Learned counsel for the respondents fairly point out at the  
outset, for, the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgment dated  
21.10.2015, rendered by this court in RFA No.4170 of 2001 (Gurjant Singh  
Vs. Union of Inida and another), and other connected matters, vide which

in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition this Court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners to ₹3,20,000/- per acre and consequently, the appeals preferred by the Union of India were dismissed. Therefore, he submits that the appeals preferred by the landowners be disposed of in terms of the decision of this Court, dated 21.10.2015, in the case of Gurjant Singh (supra) whereas, the appeals filed by the Union of India shall have to be dismissed.

Ordered accordingly.
