The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by petitioner, namely, Prabhjit Singh for quashing of the order dated 05.02.2010 (Annexure P-4) vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No.124 dated 06.10.2008 registered under Sections 406/498-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in

compliance of order passed by this Court on 23.12.2015, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court within the stipulated period and has been released on interim bail.

Since the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and co-accused of the petitioner has been acquitted of the charge, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to make all efforts to expedite the trial preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
