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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.155 dated 07.08.2012, under Sections 307/336/427/160/148/149/506 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

From the pleadings on record, it transpires that the petitioner was granted regular bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide order dated 24.08.2013 and was thereafter, regularly appearing before the trial Court. However, on account of fact that the petitioner was falsely implicated in another criminal case i.e. FIR No.26 dated 02.02.2014 registered at Police Station City Khanna, he could not appear before the trial Court. Accordingly, the benefit of bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled. Such situation necessitated the filing of the present petition.

On 22.12.2015, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is ready to appear before the Court below and he could not appear during trial as another FIR had been registered against

him on 02.02.2014 and the police had given a clean chit to him in January 2015. He states that similar direction had been given to Manjot Singh @ Monu by this Court.

Notice of motion, returnable for 15.02.2016.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner would appear before the Court below on 12.01.2016 and on his appearance, the Court below shall admit him to interim bail on his furnishing bonds to its satisfaction.

Petitioner would place on record copy of the order passed by the Court below on the next date of hearing.”

Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner has produced before this Court during the course of hearing today a certified copy of the order dated 12.01.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in terms of which petitioner has been admitted to interim bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount. Copy of the order dated 12.01.2016 is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

In view of the circumstances noticed hereinabove, present petition is allowed. Order dated 22.12.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
