This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.258 dated 14.11.2016, registered under Sections 307/323/324/506/148/149 IPC and under Section 25/27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar City.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the Court on 02.01.2017 and move an application for regular bail

which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case on or before 04.01.2017.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
