This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in pursuant to warrants of arrest issued against him vide order dated 09.11.2016 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa in case No.138-CRA-2015.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner has sought exemption but the same was rejected without even giving any reasons and bail bonds cancelled. He further states that the petitioner had never misused the concession of bail.

In my opinion, it would be appropriate if the petitioner surrenders before the Appellate Court on the date fixed which is stated to be

06.01.2017 and in case the above mentioned assertion is correct, he would be released on bail subject to payment of costs of Rs.12,000/- to be paid to the respondents No.1 and 2. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
