Report dated 18.02.2016 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amritsar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Hari Singh, injured Nirmal Singh and the accused namely Amandeep Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of the Award passed by learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Amritsar.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure accident case and the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that

compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.55 dated 13.05.2014 registered at Police Station Division 'B', Amritsar under Sections 279/337/338/427 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
