By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.796, dated 27.11.2015, registered under Sections 380, 420, 506 read with Section 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Yamunanagar, District Yamunanagar.

It is contended that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner and subsequently, he has been falsely implicated in the instant case. He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 23.12.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, the

cheque book is yet to be recovered.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and all the offences are triable by Magistrate, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.12.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
