Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Though apparently it seems to be a civil dispute as regard the Will executed by Dwarka Dass, however, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 12.11.2015 (Annexure P-3), stated to have been filed by the petitioner, and decide the same in accordance with law.
