Petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly, along with 5-6 other persons had attacked the complainant Raj Kumar on 11.10.2016.

The petitioner, as per the FIR, has not been attributed any specific injury and had allegedly gave beatings to Rohit. The grievous injury has been received by Raj Kumar complainant at the hands of Dilawar, co-accused.

In view of the said circumstances, the petitioner who has been in custody w.e.f. 05.11.2016 can be granted the concession of bail. The motive attributed is previous enmity between the parties on account of dispute at a fair.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
