Petitioner Vikas Garg has filed the present petition under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. seeking cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.3 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Barnala in FIR No.283 dated 15.10.2014, under Sections 427, 326, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala.

While admitting the respondent No.3 on bail, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Barnala has clearly observed that from the contents of the FIR, no injury was attributed to respondent No.3, who was not present at the place of alleged occurrence. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after granting bail to respondent No.3, an FIR No.7 dated 11.1.2015, under Sections 341, 342, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC has

been registered against him at Police Station City Barnala.

It has not been disputed that even in the subsequent FIR i.e. FIR No.7 dated 11.1.2015 respondent No.3 is already on bail. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to cancel the bail granted to respondent No.3.

Dismissed.
