Prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 113, dated 10.03.2009 for offences punishable under Sections 379, 411, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No. 6, District Jalandhar.

As per the allegations, the petitioner alongwith his co-accused intercepted and found in possession of stolen Indigo Car, planning to commit a serious offence.

The petitioner was granted bail and, thereafter, due to his non-appearance during the trial was declared proclaimed offender on 14.11.2011.

The petitioner is stated to have now been put in custody since 01.06.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Rakesh Kumar submits that there are two other cases pending trial against the petitioner, while in two cases he already stands convicted and sentenced.

Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
