By way of petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50, dated 25.01.2015, registered under Sections 307, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for the 'the IPC') and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sector 10, Gurgaon.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has successfully evaded the process of Court, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be taken to be an opinion on merits of the case.

However, keeping in view the fact that the compromise has been effected between the parties, the trial Court may expedite the bail petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., of the petitioner, in case he moves the same.
