INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Ashish has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.236 dated 12.07.2013, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak, under Sections 307, 392, 397 and 216 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A. G. Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations of the prosecution, the present petitioner is the main accused who fired at the complainant from a countrymade pistol which he was holding and the complainant received injury on his back. Thereafter, the present petitioner fled away from the spot in the car of the complainant.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and also in view of the fact that the present petitioner is the main accused, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, since the petitioner has been in custody since 08.09.2014, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if requires. Concerned Investigating Officer/Station House Officer is also directed to produce all the remaining prosecution witnesses for examination before the learned trial Court on the dates fixed at the earliest.
