This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.255 dated 24.6.2015 under sections 420, 419, 406, 467, 471, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Bhupani, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

F.I.R in question was registered on the complaint of Krishan Kant Bhardwaj, who stated that he responded to an advertisement in the Punjab Kesri and made contact with one Ashok Garg and Suraj Jain on two different mobile phone numbers i.e. 9650892356 and 8512873935. The aforesaid two persons held out an assurance to give Rs.50,000/- as monthly rent upon land being made available for erection of mobile towers. Complainant has further alleged that he over a period of time deposited a total sum of Rs.97,200/- in the bank accounts of Ashok Garg and Suraj Jain. Allegation in a nutshell is that such amount has been fraudulently taken from him.

Petitioner has been in custody since 7.10.2015. His name does not even figure in the complaint. It has been conceded that even the

telephone numbers on which the complainant had established contact with Ashok Garg and Suraj Jain did not belong to the petitioner. There is no entrustment of the amount in favour of the petitioner. Challan in the present case has already been submitted and the trial is still at the initial stage.

In an overview of the matter and without making any observations on merits of the case, present petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of regular bail. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.

Petition is disposed of.
