This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.281 dated 27.9.2015 under sections 384, 506 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, City-1, Abohar-Fazilka.

Briefly, it may be noticed that the F.I.R in question was registered on the complaint made by one Rajneesh Batra, who had furnished affidavits against the present petitioner on the accusation of extortion.

On 11.1.2016, petitioner was granted interim protection as regards arrest subject to his joining investigation.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Raminder Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 11.1.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
