The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 20 dated 20.02.2015 registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC and Section 302 IPC has been added later on.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had stated on the last date of hearing that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and they have not supported the prosecution version but they were unable to get copy of their statements though the copies had been applied.

Copy of the statements have been received. All the private witnesses have not supported the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 20.02.2015.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
