Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the

life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Suman Deep Singh Walia, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. A copy of the petition has been supplied to him.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age, petitioner No.1 has placed on record a photocopy of Identity Card issued by Election Commission of India (Annexure P-1) wherein his year of birth is mentioned as 1992, whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record photocopy of AADHAR card (Annexure P-2) depicting her date of birth as 25.08.1997. They have also moved a representation before respondent No.2 (Annexure P-5) for protection of their lives and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the said representation.

This order has nothing to do with regard to validity or invalidity of the marriage of the petitioners.
