JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 72, dated 09.06.2010 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474, 201 & 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated December 24, 2015, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court on the payment of Rs.5,000/- as costs. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib, has been received, in which,

it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free will, without any pressure or coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 72, dated 09.06.2010 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474, 201 & 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
