Quashing of FIR No. 589 dated 17.08.2015 under Sections 406/498-A/506/323 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Karnal, District Karnal, is being sought on the basis of compromise deed dated 26.11.2015 (Annexure P-4).

Respondent No. 2 got married to petitioner No. 1 on 18.11.2013. Due to temperamental differences, both the parties could not live together as husband and wife. The relationship between them became strain and thereafter, the F.I.R was registered against the petitioners on account of bringing less dowry and harassment caused by the petitioners.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide compromise deed dated 26.11.2015 (Annexure P-4). Further a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed on 26.11.2015 and joint statement of the parties has been recorded.

In compliance of order dated 18.07.2016, report of Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate Karnal, has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of complainant/respondent No. 2 and joint statement of petitioners have been recorded. Complainant stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioners. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the joint statement given by the petitioners. Further the police has also filed cancellation report, which has been accepted by the Court on 01.08.2016.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 589 dated 17.08.2015 under Sections 406/498-A/506/323 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Karnal, District Karnal, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of.
