The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.603, dated 11.11.2016, registered under Sections 5/13 (2), 17 of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan Act, 2015, Sections 11-59-60 of the Animal Cruelty Act, and Section 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Nuh, District Mewat.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners were not arrested from the spot and even till date the police has not been

able to establish that the truck belongs to them.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Udham Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
