JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought the concession of bail, in case bearing FIR No.368, dated November 12, 2016, under Sections 406 & 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that after the registration of the instant case, petitioner has made the payment of entire amount through her brother Gurdeep Singh, in pursuance of which, Neelam Rani Sharma has sworn an affidavit dated November 15, 2016, which has been duly attested by the Notary, Dera Bassi. The copy of the affidavit was also supplied to the Investigating Officer by the complainant-Neelam Rani Sharma. The submission of affidavit is suggestive of the fact that now no grudge exists in between the parties with regard to payment of amount in question. Otherwise also, petitioner was arrested in this case on

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November 13., 2016 and after subjecting to custodial interrogation, she was remanded to the judicial custody meaning thereby her custody was no more required. Otherwise also, as per the version of the learned State counsel, investigation in this case has been completed and challan is likely to be presented in the concerned court shortly. In the given circumstances, this court is of the considered view that it would not be justifiable to keep the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into aforesaid aspects and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition stands allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
