Through the instant petition preferred under Section 437(6) read with Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought the concession of bail pending trial, in case bearing FIR No.487, dated August 02, 2015, under Sections 392, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Concededly, petitioner was arrested in this case on August 14, 2015 and after subjecting his custodial interrogation, he was remanded to the judicial custody, meaning thereby, his custody was no more required. Even, otherwise, on conclusion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented before Jurisdictional Magistrate, who is at present seisin of the matter. Though, charge of the case was framed on October 15, 2015, yet till date no prosecution witness has been examined. The tractor trolley which was allegedly robbed of by the

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petitioner from the complainant has already been recovered. If, the facts and circumstances of the case referred to above, disposal of the challan is not likely in the near future and certainly would take sufficient long time.

Taking into aforesaid aspects and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition stands allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
