ANITA CHAUDHRY , J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0184 dated 03.10.2015, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, at Police Station SAS Nagar, Phase-1, Mohali (Punjab).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order date 23.12.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Mediation report has not been received but Mediation has failed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that all the households were returned and it is reflected in the order passed in the order dated 04.01.2016. He further submits that the complainant refused to accept the double bed and there is an observation by the Court below.

Learned counsel for the complainant has urged that the gold articles were not returned. There appears to be a dispute as to what was handed over and to whom, the question is to be addressed before the trial court.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 23.12.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
