Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Inder and Karan Singh in Complaint Case No.249 dated 07.10.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code titled as Ramesh Vs. Inder & Ors. pending in the Court of Learned JMIC, Hansi wherein they have been summoned vide order dated 07.04.2015(P-2).

Both the petitioners have been accused by the complainant Ramesh-respondent no.2 of not returning the jewellery items deposited with them being part of a Panchayat convened to settle the previous theft case

against one Sunil and Rajesh. The earlier stolen articles of the complainant Ramesh led to the file of the FIR and it is stated that an untrace report however, has been submitted in the said FIR, since the jewellery items deposited with the Panchayat members by the said Sunil and Rajesh have not been returned to the complainant nor to anybody else, the aforesaid complaint case has been filed.

Counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioners have deliberately chosen to avoid appearing before the Magistrate leading to issuance of NBWs.

Be that as it may, it is deemed appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction that in the event of both the petitioners submitting themselves before the learned trial Court within 10 days from today, they shall be released on bail subject to its satisfaction.

Disposed of in the above terms.
