The prayer is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner-Baljit Singh till the filing of chemical examiner report by the police in case FIR No.59 dated 30.05.2015, under Sections 21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered with Police Station Sadar, Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

There is a recovery of 60 grams of *Intoxicating Powder* from the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous since the petitioner has already been released on default bail in the light of the provisions of Section 167(2) Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
