Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent No.4.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sukant Gupta, Addl. P.P., U.T. Chandigarh, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has supplied copy of the petition to the learned State Counsel.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their

parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age, petitioner No.1 has placed on record a photocopy of AADHAR card (Annexure P-1) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1995, whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record photocopy of AADHAR card (Annexure P-2) depicting his year of birth as 1990. They have also moved a representation before respondent No.2 (Annexure P-4) for protection of their lives and liberty.

Marriage certificate has been shown at the time of arguments and its photocopy is taken on record.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the said representation.

This order has nothing to do with regard to validity or invalidity of the marriage of the petitioners.
