Notice issued to respondents No.4 to 6 has been received back duly served but there is no representation on their behalf.

Heard.

This is petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short "Cr.P.C") preferred by petitioner seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for providing protection to their lives and liberty as they have solemnized marriage against wishes and volition of respondents No.4 to 6.

In response to notices issued to respondents, official respondents have filed an affidavit of Parminder Singh, Deputy

Superintendent of Police, City Gurdaspur. A perusal of same transpires that neither any case has been registered against any of the petitioner nor they are wanted in any case. It has further been unfolded in the affidavit that petitioners have suffered statements by way of affidavit that they do not require any protection as they have no apprehension to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 after solemnization of their marriage.

In view of contents of affidavit filed by learned State counsel, the said petition has rendered infructuous and same is disposed of as such.
