This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.93 dated 1.7.2014 under sections 302, 148 I.P.C read with section 149 I.P.C and sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that no overt act has been attributed to the present petitioner. Only allegation is that at the time of occurrence he was present at the spot armed with a *Kirpan* and of having raised a *Lalkara*. Material prosecution witnesses already stands examined.

Petitioner is in custody since 2.7.2014.

Co-accused Avtar Singh, who was similarly situated and was stated to be present at the spot armed with a sharp edged weapon i.e. *Gandasa*, has been granted benefit of bail by this Court in the light of order dated 10.12.2015 passed in CRM No. M-36610 of 2015.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Moga.

Petition disposed of.
