The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.72 dated 17.03.2012 under sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and section 42 of Prison Act registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to agree with the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner, he submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition at this stage but learned trial Court be directed to dispose of the application for regular bail of the petitioner within three days.

Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed. In case the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court on or before 21.12.2016 the application filed by him for regular bail will be considered by learned trial Court within three days.
