This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation against respondent Nos.4 to 8 and to register a criminal case in the shape of FIR against respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.

At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated May 12, 2016 (Annexure P-5) was moved, but till date no substantive action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana , (Punjab) to decide his representation dated May 12, 2016 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated May 12, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
