On the instructions of ASI Charanjit Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Petitioner Sumanpreet Kaur is the wife of Jagdeep Singh who had allegedly committed suicide on account of the fact that the petitioner had demanded money and property to join the matrimonial house with Jagdeep Singh as she was staying with her parents. The claim of the petitioner is that she had been thrown out of the matrimonial house and no attempt had been made to rehabilitate her.

It will not be appropriate for this Court to enter into the controversy regarding the matrimonial dispute between the husband and wife, leaving two children born out of the wedlock. It would be debatable during trial whether any act and conduct of the petitioner could be said to be abetment to the deceased to commit suicide.

Petitioner having joined investigation, can be granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, she will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to all the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
