Petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly along with other accused had allegedly attacked the complainant and others. A number of injuries were suffered by the complainant. So far as petitioner is concerned individually, he has been attributed an injury with a 'dang' on the waist of the complainant. The said injury admittedly is a simple injury.

The petitioner being in custody w.e.f. 26.10.2015, can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur.
