This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought direction to respondent No. 3 to register an FIR under the provisions of law against respondent No.6 and further to take legal action against respondent No.6.

Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated February 15, 2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved to Deputy Commissioner & District Election Officer, Panchkula, but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

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At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Panchkula (Haryana) to decide his representation dated February 15, 2016 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Panchkula (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated February 15, 2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
