JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty as well as for bringing the case to its logical conclusion after taking legal action against respondents No.4 to 11.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh has submitted that after the conclusion of the investigation, cancellation report was earlier filed in the Court of learned Jurisdictional Magistrate but it was not accepted and learned Illaqa Magistrate directed the further investigation into the matter. Now again, investigation is complete and cancellation report is likely to be presented shortly in the Court of Jurisdictional Magistrate.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, instant petition has rendered infructuous and as such it stand disposed of.

However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse with the other remedies available to her under the law.
