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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 111, dated 14.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code added later on, registered at Police Station Shehzadpur, District Ambala.

As per allegations lodged by the injured/complainant-Ankush, the petitioner alongwith four other co-accused waylaid the complainant, while two of the co-accused held him and the other two co-accused inflicted *Dandas* blow. The petitioner has been attributed a sole blow with his *Khukri* (knife) below the right arm of the complainant. The said injury has been opined to be dangerous to life.

It is contended that the petitioner was earlier released on bail after completion of investigation and the same was never misused. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2015 and after framing of the charge, only one witness out of twelve witnesses

has since been examined. It is also submitted that rest of three co-accused have been released on anticipatory bail whereas the fourth one was found innocent.

Learned State counsel, assisted by ASI Tehal Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual contention.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the facts noticed above and custody period of the petitioner, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner/accused in custody since the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
