This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.132 dated 9.11.2015 under sections 399, 402 I.P.C registered at Police Station, Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, secret information was received that the petitioners herein as also three other persons were sitting along side a wall near Animal Mandi, Nabha and were hatching a plan to commit dacoity and are armed with deadly weapons. It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioners were apprehended and arrested on 9.11.2015 itself and from their possession one iron rod each has been recovered.

There is no previous history of the petitioners being involved in cases of robbery or dacoity.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has been presented on 4.1.2016. The trial, as such, would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Patiala.

Petition disposed of.
