The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Ram Raj.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of circumstantial evidence. One of the most important evidence against the petitioner is that he was last seen with the deceased as per the statement of PW Amarjeet Singh. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Amarjeet Singh has already turned hostile.

With the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner, I have gone through the statement of PW Amarjeet Singh and considered the said circumstances. It will not be appropriate for this Court at this penultimate

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stage of the trial to enter into the niceties of the trial lest it should prejudice the right of the petitioner or the prosecution agency as only three official witness remain to be examined. Next date of hearing before the trial Court is 22nd February, 2016.

Expecting that the trial would be concluded within one month after the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court, this petition is dismissed without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to raise all the pleas taken before this Court to seek acquittal if so warranted on merits.
