The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.111, dated 10.11.2016, registered under Sections 452, 341, 506, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that invocation of Section 452 of the IPC is not made out because even if the allegations are taken to be correct, the petitioners entered into the shop and not into the house. As per allegations in the FIR, actually beating took place outside

the shop and only simple injuries were caused and two persons were arrested.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from HC Rajinder Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
