Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to conduct free and fair investigation in case bearing FIR No. 338 dated December 10, 2014 under Sections 420 and 406 IPC registered at Police Station Kapurthala City, Kapurthala from any independent agency like CBI or by constituting Special Investigation Team with further prayer to direct respondent No.2 to decide representation Annexure P-2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though above-said FIR was registered on December 10, 2014 but no appropriate action has been taken. Even thereafter, a representation dated November 26, 2015 (Annexure P-2) was also moved by petitioner to respondent No.2 but till date no action has been taken.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice

on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, Punjab to look into the grievances of the petitioner unfolded by him in representation dated November 26, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and in case some substance is found therein, to take action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
