The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 14 dated 21.02.2013, under Sections 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, Sri Muktsar Sahib.
