JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 6 to initiate the appropriate proceedings against respondent Nos.8 to 11 for defrauding the petitioner of Rs.53.50 lacs and robbing the petitioner of the excavator machine worth Rs.56 lacs as well as further extending threat to his life and liberty.

Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.

At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that a complaint was moved by the petitioner way back on June 24, 2016 (Annexure P-7), but for a period of approximately six months no action has been taken by the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar till date.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated June 24, 2016 (Annexure P-7) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
