By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner Dinesh Kumar has sought pre-arrest, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case bearing FIR No. 393, dated August 13, 2016, under Sections 420, 467, 467, 471, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind, during the pendency of trial.

The allegations against the petitioner is that he succeeded in procuring Rs.6 lacs on the pretext of providing Government job to the complainant. Not only this, he issued or got issued a forged joining letter. Otherwise also, instant case was registered on 13.08.2016 and petitioner is still at large. Moreover, there are other persons also who were engaged in such illegal activities and duping the innocent persons under the garb of providing them Government jobs.

In view of the serious and grave allegations against the petitioner, this Court is of the considered view that no case is made out to exercise the discretionary powers, as envisaged under Section 438 Cr.P.C. and his custodial interrogation would certainly un-earth all the ramifications involved in such activities.

In the light of the fact narrated above, instant petition stands dismissed.
