Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.8, dated 04.01.2016, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, Police Station Women, District Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the recovery has been effected. He has placed on record the list of articles taken under the Right to Information Act, 2005. He further says that pursuant to order dated 08.02.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation .
